# **Volunteer Safety Guidelines**

**I. Purpose** The purpose of these Safety Guidelines is to ensure the well-being of volunteers, clients, and staff while promoting a safe and secure environment for all activities conducted by Guided Path Terminal Cancer Support ("the Organization").

#### II. General Safety Rules

- 1. Always prioritize your safety and the safety of others during volunteer activities.
- 2. Report any unsafe conditions, hazards, or incidents to your supervisor immediately.
- 3. Adhere to all instructions provided during training and follow organizational policies and procedures.
- 4. Avoid engaging in tasks that you are not trained or authorized to perform.

#### **III. Personal Safety**

- 1. Dress appropriately for your volunteer role. Appropriate dress may depend on event location and format.
- 2. Stay hydrated and take breaks as needed to avoid fatigue.
- 3. Avoid working alone in isolated areas; ensure you have a partner or supervisor present.
- 4. Refrain from lifting heavy objects or performing strenuous activities without proper training or assistance.

#### **IV. Client Interactions**

- 1. Always maintain professional boundaries with clients and their families.
- 2. Respect the privacy and dignity of clients; never share their personal information without consent.
- 3. If a client becomes distressed or exhibits behavior that poses a risk, remain calm and notify your supervisor immediately.
- 4. Do not administer medications or perform medical tasks.



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### V. Transportation Safety

- 1. Avoid using personal vehicles for transportation of clients unless approved by the Organization.
- 2. Volunteers who transport clients or supplies must hold a valid driver's license, show proof of insurance and agree to a driving record check.
- 3. Ensure that vehicles are in good working condition and that all passengers wear seat belts.
- 4. Follow all traffic laws and drive responsibly.

### **VI. Emergency Preparedness**

- 1. Familiarize yourself with emergency procedures, including evacuation routes and contact numbers.
- 2. Carry a charged phone and emergency contact information during volunteer activities.
- 3. In the event of an emergency, prioritize personal safety and follow the instructions of emergency personnel.
- 4. Notify your supervisor as soon as possible after an emergency incident.

#### **VII. Infectious Disease Precautions**

- 1. Follow current health guidelines, including wearing masks, maintaining physical distance, and practicing good hand hygiene.
- 2. Avoid volunteering if you feel unwell or have been exposed to contagious illnesses.
- 3. Sanitize any shared equipment or surfaces after use.

### **VIII. Reporting and Documentation**

- 1. Report any accidents, injuries, or safety concerns to your supervisor immediately.
- 2. Complete an Incident Report Form for all accidents or near-miss incidents.
- 3. Document and report any unusual situations involving clients or fellow volunteers.



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### **IX. Prohibited Activities**

- 1. Volunteers must not:
  - Use alcohol or illegal substances while performing volunteer duties.
  - Smoke or vape around clients or in view during public events.
  - Bring weapons of any kind or hazardous materials to volunteer sites or events.
  - Engage in any activities that compromise the safety or reputation of the Organization.
